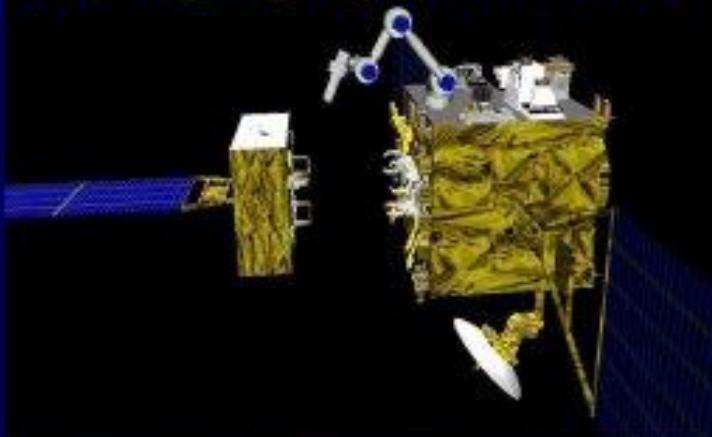
His seminar will highlight his contribution to HAYABUSA-2 (Japanese asteroid sample return probe) and micro satellites development.

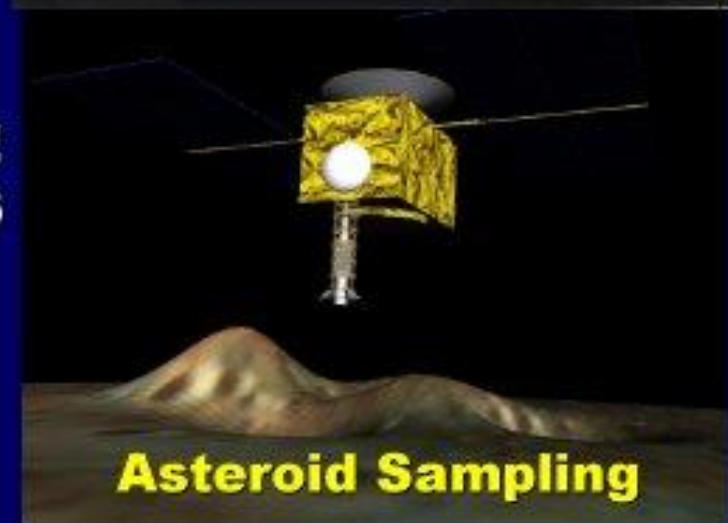
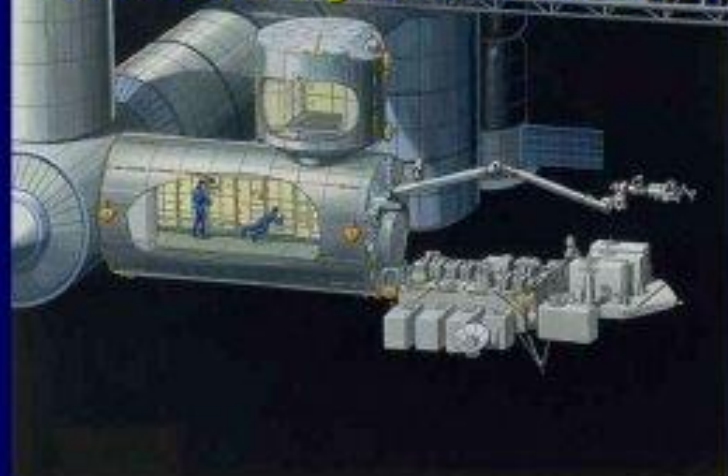
